If spotted, PLEASE DO NOT CALL TO HER, CHASE or ATTEMPT TO CATCH HER. Please only watch/follow quietly at a distance and call us with her current location as soon as possible. We would like to locate where she is most commonly bedding down at night in an attempt to catch her by placing a humane live trap there overnight. If you *are* able to trap her in a secure structure (such as a garage, outbuilding, shed, etc.) or in a fenced yard, please leave her there until we arrive.

*** **She has a distinctive cowlick (ridge) down her back from her shoulders to her hips (see last picture).** ***
